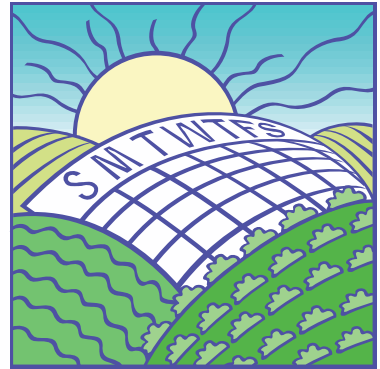
Nominating forms may be picked up at Town Hall, the Library, and many businesses around Town as well as the Chamber office. The deadline for submission is April 1st.
